### Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS)







Adichunchangiri University (ACU), through Adichunchanagiri Hospital's (ACH) leadership, has undertaken a pioneering initiative to provide free, nutritious meals to all inpatients and their caretakers, irrespective of their socioeconomic background. This program aims to alleviate food insecurity concerns for patients and their families during a crucial time, allowing them to focus on healing and recovery.

This initiative by ACU strongly aligns with several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations. Here's a breakdown of the connections:

- **SDG 2: Zero Hunger:** ACU directly combats hunger (SDG 2) by ensuring inpatients and caretakers have access to three meals daily. This is especially crucial for those facing financial difficulties during a hospitalization.
- SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being: Adequate nutrition is fundamental for healing and recovery (SDG 3). By
  providing doctor-recommended meals, ACU supports patients' well-being and expedites their return to
  good health.
- **SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities:** Free food transcends financial barriers, promoting equity in healthcare access (SDG 10) and ensuring everyone receives proper nourishment during hospitalization, regardless of their economic status.

### **Program Details:**

- Beneficiaries: The program serves approximately 400 inpatients and 400 caretakers each day, benefiting around 800 people in total per day. This results in about 2,400 meals being served daily, taking into account breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Since 2018, nearly 57,600 patients and caretakers have been positively impacted by this program, demonstrating ACU's dedication to community welfare and health. Patients receive doctor-recommended meals tailored to their health requirements, while caretakers are provided with balanced, nutritious meals.
- Impact and Growth of the Initiative: Since the establishment of Adichunchanagiri Hospital, the practice of providing free meals has been a cornerstone of its operations. Over the years, under ACU's leadership, the number of inpatients has increased, indicating the growing impact and necessity of this initiative. The hospital's commitment to this program is reflected in the significant financial investment made to sustain it. In the past five years, approximately ₹30 lakh rupees have been spent annually on providing free food. However, this expenditure has seen a substantial increase, rising to ₹57 lakhs in the 2022-23 period. This increase underscores the hospital's dedication to scaling up its support as the number of beneficiaries grows.

The free food program at Sri Adichunchanagiri Mahasamsthana Math, associated with Adichunchanagiri University, extends beyond patients and caretakers. The Math provides free meals daily to visitors, offering three meals a day to nearly 2.5 lakh visitors per month on regular days and up to 12 lakh visitors on special occasions. Additionally, 3,500 students studying in the free residential institutions at Sri Math benefit from this initiative. This commitment underscores its dedication to serving the community.



# SANKALP Free Plastic Surgery Camp - Cleft Lip, Cleft Palate and Post Burns Contracture

Adichunchanagiri University (ACU) is proud to be a key partner in the Sankalp initiative, a free plastic surgery camp dedicated to empowering individuals affected by cleft lip, cleft palate, and post-burn contractures. Sankalp goes beyond mere medical intervention; it marks a transformative journey that restores not just physical appearance, but also the self-esteem and confidence of these individuals. This initiative embodies ACU's core commitment to social responsibility and aligns perfectly with several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations.

- **SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being:** By providing free surgeries, consultations, medicines, and post-operative care, Sankalp ensures access to quality healthcare for those who may not otherwise afford it. This directly contributes to improved physical and mental health outcomes for beneficiaries (SDG Target 3.4).
- **SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities:** Sankalp prioritizes those facing economic hardship, promoting social inclusion and reducing healthcare inequalities (SDG Target 10.1).

SANKALP represents a powerful international and national collaboration. From 2006 to 2023, a total of 2,643 patients were registered for surgeries. Over the years, 963 surgeries were performed for cleft lip and palate, and 139 for post-burn contractures, benefiting a total of 1,102 patients. This collective effort ensures comprehensive care, offering free consultations, medication, food, and accommodation throughout the process at Adichunchanagiri Hospital. Post-surgical consultations are also provided at no cost, demonstrating a long-term commitment to patient well-being.

### **Investing in Shared Expertise:**

ACU proudly contributes ₹14 lakhs as a partner with Rotaplast International USA. This investment fuels the program, allowing us to leverage the expertise of a dedicated team of medical professionals. Surgeons from Rotaplast International collaborate seamlessly with ACU's esteemed staff at Adichunchanagiri Hospital. This combined force creates a synergy that delivers exceptional, transformative healthcare, exceeding expectations and empowering patients to lead fulfilling lives.



### Free Total Knee Replacement Camp

Adichunchanagiri University (AU), with a deep commitment to social responsibility, actively supports initiatives that improve the health and well-being of the community. In line with this vision, the Department of Orthopaedics at the Adichunchanagiri Hospital partnered with its dedicated alumni to organize a first-of-its-kind "Free Total Knee Replacement Camp." This camp aimed to provide free and accessible surgical care to individuals suffering from debilitating knee conditions, significantly impacting their quality of life.

This initiative directly aligns with several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations.

- **SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being:** By offering free total knee replacements, the camp directly addresses SDG 3, ensuring healthy lives and promoting well-being for all ages. It alleviates pain, improves mobility, and empowers individuals to lead more active and fulfilling lives.

**The Camp's Impact:** Held from January 18th to February 20th, 2024, in commemoration of Paramapoojya Jagadguru Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji's birth anniversary, the camp witnessed a remarkable response.

- Patient Participation: A total of 128 patients registered for the surgery, highlighting the significant need for such initiatives.
- Successful Surgeries: Following thorough examinations, 78 patients underwent successful total knee replacement surgeries. This life-changing procedure, performed by esteemed alumni surgeons Dr. T N Balakrishna Gowda, Dr. Mahendra, and Dr. Bhuvan Prashanth B N, has undoubtedly improved their mobility and quality of life.
- Comprehensive Care: The program encompassed more than just surgery. Beneficiaries received free consultations, medications, food, and accommodation throughout their stay. Additionally, post-surgery consultations were provided at no cost, ensuring continued support during their recovery journey.

**Financial Commitment:** The estimated cost of the program stands at a commendable **64 lakhs**. This significant investment by AU and its alumni demonstrates their unwavering dedication to making quality healthcare accessible to all.



### **Artificial Limb Fitment Camp**

Adichunchanagiri University (ACU) is proud to support the Artificial Limb Fitment Camp organized by Adichunchagiri Hospital (AIMS) in association with the Karnataka Marwari Youth Federation (KMYF) from May 29th to June 7th, 2023. This initiative aligns perfectly with ACU's core values of social responsibility and inclusivity, contributing to several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) outlined by the United Nations. The primary objective of the camp is to provide free, high-quality artificial limbs to individuals in need. This empowers them to regain mobility and independence, fostering a sense of dignity and improving their overall well-being. This initiative directly aligns with several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations.

- SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being: By equipping individuals with artificial limbs, the camp directly contributes to improved health outcomes. Recipients can regain lost physical function, manage daily activities more effectively, and potentially reduce the risk of secondary complications associated with limb loss

### **Camp Details and Support**

The Artificial Limb Fitment Camp was a significant event held at Adichunchanagiri Hospital in B.G. Nagar. It was organized by the Shree Maravadi Yuvaka Sangha, Bangalore, and attracted a considerable number of beneficiaries. A total of 285 individuals registered for the camp, with 248 of them receiving inpatient care. The camp focused on providing prosthetic limbs, with 6 beneficiaries receiving artificial hands and 242 receiving artificial legs. Among the leg recipients, 235 were single leg amputees, with 95 above knee and 147 below knee amputations, and 7 received prosthetics for both legs.

The total cost of the camp was approximately 1,992,000 INR, shared between Adichunchanagiri Hospital and the Karnataka Marwari Youth Federation. Dr. Uttamchand Khincha, Dr. F.R Singhvi, and Sri D. Devaraju offered their services as part of a financial collaboration to provide free surgery, consultations, meals, and accommodation to those in need. Additionally, they provided free post-surgery consultations to ensure continued support during the recovery process. This financial collaboration ensured that all services provided, including surgery, consultations, food, and accommodation, were free of charge for the beneficiaries. Post-surgery consultations were also offered at no cost, ensuring continuous support during the recovery process.



### **BGS WALKATHON**

Blood sugar tests are also available for those over 35. his initiative has benefited over 100 people for Cardio Chekup and nearly 500 for Blood Sugar Test. This underscores ACU's dedication to proactive health management within the community.

Financial Commitment to Community Health: The dedication of ACU towards this initiative is further emphasized by the significant financial investment. An estimated ₹8 lakhs are allocated annually to cover the costs associated with refreshments, T-shirts, and most importantly, the free health screenings. ### Championing Preventive Healthcare for a Healthier Community



Notably, the hospital provides free kidney dialysis to approximately 300 patients annually, offering a life-saving treatment that is often out of reach for many. Since its inception, AHRC has benefitted a remarkable 2,160 patients with this critical service alone. Additionally, students and staff receive a 50% concession on treatment charges, further supporting the community's health and well-being.

The hospital witnesses an impressive daily walk-in rate, ranging from 500 to a remarkable 1800 patients seeking medical attention. During 2022-23 alone, the university generously allocated ₹2.5 crores for these initiatives, translating to an average monthly expenditure of ₹21 lakhs. 



### A Hub for Research and Innovation Focused on Health and Society



**Spreading the Light of Spirituality Across America:** ACSF USA meticulously planned and organized these Satsangs, strategically holding them in prominent locations across the country. **Major cities like Detroit, Chicago, Richmond, Washington DC, Charlotte, Dallas, and Austin all played host to these spiritual events.** The intention was to attract a diverse audience, encompassing not only existing devotees familiar with the Foundation's traditions but also members of the general public with a curiosity about spirituality.

The central figure in these Satsangs was the highly respected Mahaswamiji, a revered spiritual leader. Through insightful and engaging discourses, the chief pontiff delved into the core tenets of spirituality, offering practical guidance for enhancing overall well-being. The content of the Satsangs extended beyond traditional religious teachings. The discourses explored a rich tapestry of subjects, weaving together spirituality, education, science, and technology. This interdisciplinary approach aimed to create an inclusive atmosphere, welcoming both established devotees and individuals from the wider community with an interest in spiritual exploration.

Organizers envisioned sizable gatherings, estimating an average attendance of around **1,500 people at each event.** This targeted high participation rate reflected the Foundation's commitment to fostering a vibrant and diverse spiritual community within the United States. The inspiration for these Satsangs stemmed from the large-scale gatherings held by the **Sri Adichunchanagiri Mahasamsthana Math in Karnataka, India, which routinely attract over 5,000 attendees**. ACSF USA aimed to replicate the spirit of inclusivity and spiritual connection on a smaller but impactful scale within the American context.

The Adichunchanagiri Satsang Series stands as a testament to ACSF USA's commitment to sharing the light of spirituality with a broad American audience.
