








Organizational Structure








Personality Enrichment Programmes and Opportunities



Admission Process & Guidelines

Admission Process

Step-1	The Admission notification for class VI will be announced during the first week of December every year. Visiting the campus for further information is advised.				
Step-2	The SAMVIT Institution Counsellor will explain the institution's philosophy and provide information about the courses offered. If you are interested, the Counsellor will guide you through the admission process. Once you understand the process, you can obtain the application form and fill it out completely. It is important to ensure that the application is submitted before the deadline.				
Step-3	When assessing applicants, the primary criteria will be their performance in Mental Ability, Kannada, English, and Mathematics. The questions will be based on the student's syllabus, general knowledge, and common sense. Oral tests will also be conducted to evaluate their reading ability.

Admission Guidelines

ADMISSION PRIORITY: Children below the Poverty Line and talented are eligible

- 1st priority Children who have NO parents.
- 2nd priority Children who have a single parent
- 3rd priority Children with extraordinary academic records or co-curricular ability

POST ADMISSION:

The Institution facilitates the smooth transition of the student and their parents. Orientation Programs for the parents are planned to impart the policies of the institution.

WAITING LISTS

Those students who have all requisite admissions criterion requirements, but due to lack of vacancy, he/she may not get the seat in the first round of announcement. According to the norms, we will put those names on the waiting list. If any vacancies, listed students may get admission. The list is dissolved at the end of the academic year. If the students seek admission in the following year, students have to apply afresh.

PROMOTIONS AND DETENTIONS

- Students are given periodical tests to assess progress and the reports are shown to parents during parent meetings.
- Promotion of students to the next higher standard will be based on their performance in all the tests and examinations from time to time throughout the year.
- Students found persistently weak in studies or failing to score as per requirement in the Annual Examination will not be allowed to continue in the institution.


